Dear Statutory Consultee,

Re: TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER SCHEME: PROPOSED EXTENSION TO EXISTING 30MPH SPEED LIMIT ON B4224, FOWNHOPE, HEREFORDSHIRE.

I write on behalf of Herefordshire Council to advise you of the proposal to implement a north-westerly extension to the existing 30mph speed limit on the B4224 in the village of Fownhope, Herefordshire.

The measures are proposed in association with the ongoing residential development to the north-east of the B4224. The access for this development is directly onto the B4224 in a location that is currently under a national speed limit. Therefore, there is a requirement to relocate the 30mph speed limit terminals north-west, in order to include the development and its access within the 30mph village speed limit. This project is also in conjunction with existing highway improvement works currently being undertaken within the village.

The measures have also been proposed for the following reasons:

- 1. For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road, or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
- 2. For the preservation and improvement of the amenity of the area concerned.
- 3. To improve safety for local residents who will reside in the new development.

A plan showing the proposals along with new signing required, should the scheme be implemented, is attached to this letter.

A Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) process has now been initiated and this is the <u>Formal</u> (<u>Statutory</u>) <u>Consultation stage of the TRO process</u>.
