Dear Resident/Occupier,

We need to let you know about some works which will be taking place on the **B4224 Fownhope**. We will be carrying out works to implement traffic calming measures through the village, such as resurfacing, lining, and the installation of signage. We will also be carrying out works on the footways.

The works will be taking place under a road closure, from Monday 12th February 2024 to (and including) Wednesday 21st February 2024.

From Monday 12th to Sunday 18th February, the road will be closed between 8pm and 5pm each day and from Monday 19th to Wednesday 21st February, the road will be closed between 9:30am and 3pm each day, to minimise the impact on school traffic. When the road closure is removed at the end of each day, two-way temporary traffic lights will be put in place to manage the flow of traffic during the evening and overnight.

Access will be maintained for residents and businesses within the road closure, although there may be a delay whilst machinery and equipment is moved off the road to allow vehicles to get through the closure safely. There will be dedicated marshals on site to assist you with any queries about access.

The fully signed diversion route will be via the B4224 / Dormington / A438 Trumpet / A4172 Preston Cross / A449 / B4224 and vice versa.

We are sorry for any inconvenience this may cause you. At Balfour Beatty we work in partnership with Herefordshire Council to minimise the impact of our work and try to keep all disruption to a minimum - we appreciate your patience.

The programme of work may change in certain circumstances, such as bad weather. This may happen at short notice and without further notification. All changes will be highlighted on the advance warning signs, which you'll find onsite at the roadworks.
