We haven't yet held the May meeting, which will be the Annual Meeting of the Parish Council, as it is being held later than normal because of the Local Council elections which took place on the 4th May, so, I shall be talking a little about the new council and summarising the Annual Parish Meeting, which was held on the 23rd April.

Community Event to celebrate the Coronation of King Charles III:

Firstly, and briefly as there is a more detailed article elsewhere in the Flag, I'd just like to recognise another excellent community event, organised by volunteers, to celebrate the Coronation of King Charles III on Bank Holiday Monday. The weather may have been disappointing, but the dedication of all those involved in organising the event and the support of those who came along (without whom it would have been a complete disaster) was most certainly not! Thanks everyone, it just goes to show that Fownhope never disappoints!

Local Council Elections and Parish Council Vacancies:

The Local Council Elections took place on Thursday 4th May. Fownhope Parish Council has 12 seats and received 9 nominations. The election was therefore non-contested (as were most, though not all, parishes in Herefordshire), and all 9 candidates were elected. This leaves 3 vacancies and we are keen to fill these as quickly as possible.
