

Five Flowers For Fownhope

An opportunity to discover the wildflowers that grow along the lanes, paths, woodland edges and grassy areas of Fownhope.

Walk the paths – a couple of short routes are suggested below – and see if you can discover any of the Five Flowers. Put a tick on your sheet and take a photograph of you beside the flower. Leave the flower where it is to continue growing. If you send the photograph of you beside the flowers to clerk@fownhopeparishcouncil.gov.uk we will then select some photographs for the back cover of the Fownhope Flag. We would love to fill the Flag with your Fownhope flowers.

Also we would love it if you could take a photo of yourself with your FFF sheet filled in and tell us where you found your flowers.

Short footpath routes around Fownhope for children. Please always walk with an adult.

Follow Common Hill Lane up the hill whilst looking for flowers on the banks on either side of the lane. Reach the pump and walk up to Five Ways. Turn left onto the Wye Valley Walk. Once you reach the highest point turn left down past the quarry, in front of Broom Cottage and down the green lane to the bottom of Common Hill Lane. A short cut is to turn left in front of the Folly and along past Little Barn to join the path to the green lane below Broom Cottage.
