Fownhope Parish Council: Providing Leadership in Planning for the Future of the Community:

- The Parish Council Working Group for Planning consider each and every planning application received, assessing them against the adopted Neighbourhood Development Plan and the Climate Emergency Declaration, and attending site visits where necessary. All council members are invited to attend site visits and to submit their views regardless of whether they are on the working group. Comments are reported at a meeting of full council for decision by full council. Members of the public are invited to attend the monthly full meeting of the Parish Council and are able to comment on planning applications during the open session.
- The Parish Council Working Group for Planning conduct an annual assessment of the Neighbourhood Development Plan and provide a report to the Annual Parish Meeting. They continue to encourage applicants to consider the Neighbourhood Development Plan before submitting an application.
- The Parish Council Working Group for Planning consider and prepare responses to all Herefordshire Council surveys in relation to planning matters, and present a report to a meeting of full council for decision by full council.
- The Parish Council Working Group for Planning investigate any complaints about developments not being carried out in accordance with approved plans, and present a report to a meeting of full council if appropriate.
